



BORN TO PLAY THE part of cottage china, you would say of this set, of which our artist has sketched three or four pieces in the group above. Decorated in the deep, clear Cobalt blue beloved of the artistic-minded housekeeper, the pattern is developed in a dotted wreath effect inside two narrow bands. Moreover it possesses the advantage of being an open stock design, making possible the buying of as many or as few dishes as desired, and of replacing of breakages. 


