IV.

This Society shall be governed by a General Committee of members, consisting of not less than twenty, from whom the Executive Committee shall be elected. All vacancies occurring in the General Committee shall be filled by election at a regular meeting of the Committee.

V.

The Officers of the Society shall be, two Honorary Presidents, one President, three Vice-Presidents, one Secretary, one Treasurer.

The officers, together with 10 members, shall constitute an Executive Committee. The Officers and General Committee shall be elected by ballot at the annual meeting of members, and shall hold their respective offices for the term of one year and until their successors are elected. Officers shall be *ex-officio* members of all standing committees.

VI.

The *President* shall preside at all meetings of the Society, shall nominate the chairwoman of all standing and special committes, shall call special meetings at discretion, and shall have the object and general good of the Society in charge.

VII.

The *Vice-Presidents*, 1st, 2nd and 3rd, in order named, shall, in the absence of the President, perform the ordinary duties of the President. Vice-Presidents are eligible as chairwomen of standing and special committees.

VIII.

The Secretary shall keep a record of the proceedings of the Society, of the General and Executive Committees, and of all
