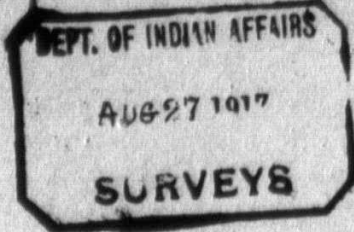

I beg to acknowledge receipt of Department letter No. 277030, August 8th, with regard to C.N.R. Right of Way. The valuation I made on this property was based on the town assessment of the land and is no doubt a pretty high figure. I personally think that half the assessment would be nearer the exact value, and in my previous letter I mentioned this being under the impression that the Department would agree to the special figure of the C.N.R.
