Last Letter Home a Remarkable Epistle
That Wins Place of Honor in London
Daily.

(London Daily Mail.)
We have received from W. L. Town-
send, of 2, 3 and 4 New Basinghall
street, London, E.C., the following copy
of a letter from his son, Second-Lieu-
tenant E. L. Townsend, London Regi-
ment, who was killed in France on Sep-
tember 15, leading the first wave against
the German position. The letter was
enclosed in the gallant boy's will, to be
opened only in the event of his death.
"I send it to you," writes the father,
"because I think it contains some fine
thoughts which may, perhaps, bring
comfort to other families."
