PRISONER OF BULGARIANS

When Lady Ralph Paget made one
of the supreme sacrifices of the war
and refused to desert the wounded Ser-
bian soldiers in her hospital at Ustuh,
thus falling into the hands of a ruthless
enemy, among those who elected to re-
main with her was a former Hampton
girl, Dr. Catherine Travis, who has been
in Serbia on Lady Paget's staff for some
months.

Lady Paget and her staff were given
an opportunity to escape but a few
hours before the Bulgarians occupied the
town and this is told of in a special
gash despatch dated November 15, from
W. G. Shepherd who is at Monastir for
the United Press.
