

BUSINESS TO WHICH PRESBYTERIES ARE REQUIRED  
TO GIVE ATTENTION.

1. Paragraph 17 of the Section on Presbyteries, and Paragraph 7 of the Section on Synod in Form of Polity, Book I. (vide Minutes pp. 48, 50).
2. Overture from the Presbytery of Victoria anent the Status of Retired Ministers. (Minutes pp. 25).
3. Books II. and III. of the Form of Polity. (Minutes 37).
4. Presbyteries are required to collect and report to the Managers of the Ministers' Widows' and Orphans' Fund the names and ages of the children of Ministers within their bounds. (Minutes pp. 72).
5. Presbyteries are required to inquire at each ordinary meeting and record in their minutes, what congregations within their bounds have made the Special Collection or Collections in behalf of the Schemes of the Church falling due since their previous meeting. (Act anent Public Collections, Minutes pp. 35).
