

MINUTES, &c.



MONDAY, June 24th, 1839.

The introductory Sermon preached by Bro. Pryor, from 1 Cor. 1 chap. 23d and 24th vs. A collection was taken in aid of Missions. Prayer was offered by bro. Viditoe, in the absence of Elder Harding, the former Moderator.

Elder T. S. Harding was appointed Moderator, bro. W. Chipman, Clerk, and bro. J. W. Nutting, Assistant Clerk. Brethren E. A. Crawley, and J. Pryor, were appointed to read the Letters, and J. Chase and J. Ferguson, to examine them.
