Dr. Fowler presented and read the report of the Education committee.

Moved by Dr. Rosebrugh, seconded by Dr. Rogers, that the report of the registration committee be referred to a committee of the whole. Dr. Fenwick in the chair.

On motion the committe rose. President in the chair.

Dr. Fenwick presented the report of the committee of the whole on the Registration committee report. On motion report received without amendment, and on motion adopted without amendment, as follows:

The Registration committee beg to recommend as follows:-

That the petition from a number or students in their third year asking to be exempt from the requirements of this Council re the snmmer session be granted. That the petition of J. J. Hayes, a licentiate of New Brunswick asking to be permitted to come up for final examination, be not granted and he with the regulations of the Council. The petition of Mr. Cody who has not passed in Latin asking to be allowed matriculation and admitted to the professional examinations be not granted. The petition of Thomas Wickett to be allowed matriculation on a third class certificate of 1885 without Latin be not granted.

The petition of H. Waddell who was taken ill during the examinations, asking to be allowed his written examinations and to come up for his oral in September be not granted. That the petition of Messrs McCoy and Killborn asking to be allowed to come up for the primary examination in September, be not granted. That the petition of P. P. Park applying for registration be granted. That the petition of Mrs. Higgin botham to be registered as a midwife, be not granted.

The petitions of A. E. Barber, J. R. Lancaster, George H. Field asking to be registered as matriculates, not having fully complied with the requirements, your committee does not think it advisable to establish the precedent of allowing examinations which are only partial requirements, and recommend that the petitions be not granted. The petitions of Messrs Gimby, McGee, Clune, Speers, McDonald and McLean for permits to practice, be not granted.
