

SPORTS PASTIME OF PASSENGERS

CRICKET AND BASEBALL PLAYED ON ZEALANDIA

Defective Cylinder Delays Vessel in Run From Antipodes to This Port

(From Thursday's Issue) Including in all kinds of sport on the spacious decks of the big steamship, the many passengers who arrived here yesterday afternoon on the Canadian-Australian line Zealandia, Capt. Phillips, state that the trip from the Antipodes permitted them to have one of the finest times of their lives. So splendid were the weather conditions that scarcely a day passed by in which cricket, golf, baseball or some other game was not played. The Zealandia's decks are so arranged that almost any kind of sport can be indulged in and for that reason so many persons prefer to travel on her rather than any of the other vessels of the line.

Although the Zealandia encountered exceptionally fine weather throughout the passage, still she was late in arriving here, being expected early Tuesday afternoon. The cause of the delay was due to one of the cylinders being damaged. The trouble occurred before the vessel left Sydney and she had made the passage for the greater part minus one of her propelling powers. Despite this disadvantage the vessel ran in twenty-three days.

Amongst the most distinguished passengers aboard the steamship was Zealandia Phillips Rutherford, the first son of Mrs. J. S. Rutherford of Nanaimo, who came into this world just before the vessel reached Honolulu. What should the baby be named? Phillips, after the steamer, was the question which worried the minds of nearly every passenger aboard. At last some thoughtful genius suggested it be named Zealandia in honor of the ship, and Phillips, after the esteemed commander of the vessel, The christening was held, venerable Archdeacon Bloor performing the brief ceremony, bestowing the title name on the child.

Most of the passengers who arrived on the Zealandia were bound for England to attend the coronation. Amongst those who will be present at that great pageant will be Hon. Frank Wilson, premier of Western Australia, together with Mrs. and Miss Wilson, Miss Sommers (daughter of Chas. Sommers, M.L.C. of Western Australia), C. Treadgold (private secretary), and Sir Edward Wittenoom, now a member of the Western Australian Upper House. Hon. Mr. Wilson was met at the outer dock by John Wilson of this city, his nephew, and his brother, Mr. Wilson of Sunderland, Eng., who journeyed here to accompany Hon. Mr. Wilson and his party to the old land.

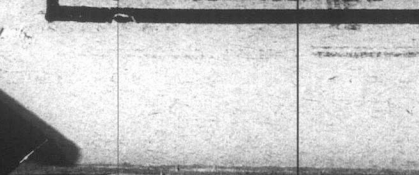
