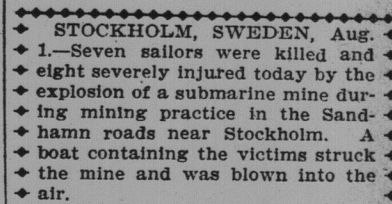

## EVIDENCE INDICATES HARTLEY'S ASSAILANTS

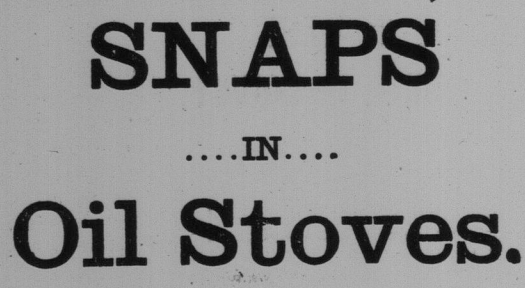
