TAXES FOR 1858.

THE Assessors of Rates and Taxes for the City of Saint John hereby give notice, that the Assessments for the present year are now being made up. By Law regulating the assessments of Real Estate, the Assessors are directed to assess the same, within thirty days after the publication of this notice, further the Assessors, with a statement on oath, in writing, of his Real Estate in the City, and of his Personal Estate, and of his Income, specifying therein the value of the Real Estate, and the value of his Personal Estate, and his Income—and such persons shall be rated accordingly.

The Assessors request that all persons having transferred, sold, or disposed of, or purchased Real Estate in the City, will give early intimation thereof, in order that the said respective Properties may be correctly entered in the Assessment Lists.

The following section from the Revised Statutes are qualified for general information:

"Every male person of the age of twenty-one years or upwards; being a British subject, and not subject to any legal incapacity, who shall have been assessed to any tax for the year for which the Registry is made up, and the result of the assessment, to the amount of twenty-five pounds, or Proportion thereof, and his Personal and Real, amounting together to one hundred pounds, or one hundred pounds annual Income, shall be qualified to vote for the Representatives of the County or City for which he shall be assessed."

For the purpose of Assessment, every person residing on business in the Parish shall be deemed an inhabitant thereof." (see, 19, c. 55, Revised Statutes.)
