Calgary, Aug. 28.—Sunny Alberta with its millions of acres of fertile wheat lands; its miles of rolling foot-hills, the ideal ranching district of America; and its superabundance of coal lying dormant in the northern and westera ranges of the province, faces a greater peril in the proposed reciprocity agreement than any other part of the west. The climate here is milder in winter than in Saskatchewan and Manitoba; interests are more varied and farming is possibly more advanced than in any other part of the prairie country, all of which has brought an unusually large number of Americans into Alberta.
