It is the business of a beligerent oper-ating on the high seas, not the duty of a neutral, to prevent contraband from reaching an enemy. Those in this country who sympathize with Ger-many and Austria-Hungary appear to assume that some obligation rests up-on this government, in the perform-ance of its neutral duty, to prevent all trade in contraband, and thus to equalize the difference due to the rela-ive naval strength of the beligerents. No such obligation exists; it would be in unneutral act, an act of partiality-in the part of this government, to idopt such a policy, if the executive had the power to do so.
