

RICHARD, AMBROSE D., LL.B.

Of French Acadian descent. S. of David Richard and Julie Ouelette. B. at Memramcook, N.B., 5 Feb., 1850. Ed. at St. Joseph Coll. there, and at St. Dunstan's Coll. Charlottetown, P.E.I. Graduated at Boston Univ., and obtained the degree of LL.B., 4 June, 1879. Called to the Bar, N.B., 23 June, 1879. M., 1 Oct., 1884, Miss Lizzie V. Holt, of Memramcook. Was elected to the Municipal Council of Westmoreland, Co. of Dorchester, 25 Oct., 1879, and has been a Commr. in and for the Co. of Westmoreland, under ch. 38 and 43 Con. Stat., N.B. Apptd. a mem. of the Leg. Council 20 May, 1882, being the first of his nationality yet apptd. A Liberal Conservative.—*Dorchester, N.B.*

RITCHIE, ALLAN.

RYAN, JAMES, J.P.

S. of Mr. Matthew Ryan, who served in the British army for many years, was present at Waterloo, and d. in N.B. in 1870, when within six weeks of being 100 years old. B. in Kings, N.B., 15 March, 1821. Ed. in N.B. M., 1848, Elizabeth, dau. of Jacob Trites, Esq. Was a school teacher at one time, and subsequently engaged in farming. Apptd. a J.P. in 1854. Is Warden of Co. of Albert. Was an unsuccessful candidate for Ho. of Assem. at g.e., 1867. Sat in Ho. of Assem. from g.e. 1870 until apptd. to L.C., 3 May, 1878. A Liberal.—*Middle Coverdale.*

WHITE, GEORGE WILLIAM.

Grandfather emigrated to St. John, N.B., from U.S., after the American Revolution. B. 12 May, 1826, in Queen's Co., N.B. Ed. at the Common Sch. M., 17 Nov., 1849, Mary Wiggins, dau. of the late Eben Wiggins. Was a farmer, and has been a merchant for some years. Is Parish Court Commr. and Coroner for the Parish of Wilmot. Sat in the Council Board of the same parish for four years. Was a mem. of the Executive Council from April, 1872, until Aug., 1873. Sat in the Ho. of Assem. for Carleton from Nov., 1868, until 1873, when he resigned, and was an unsuccessful candidate for the
