
HOUSE OF ASSEMBLY,

SATURDAY, 28th January, 1815.

RESOLVED, That a Committee of Five Members be appointed to enquire into the state and progress of Education as resulting from the Provincial Act of the Forty-first George the Third, Chapter Seventeenth, which provides for the establishment of Free Schools, and the advancement of learning in this Province; with power to send for persons and papers.

ORDERED, That Mr. *Blanchet*, Mr. *Viger*, Mr. *Vallières*, Mr. *Taschereau*, and Mr. *Borgia* do compose the said Committee.

TUESDAY, 28th February, 1815.

ORDERED, That Mr. *A. Stuart* and Mr. *Lee* be added to the Committee appointed on the 28th January last, to enquire into the state and progress of Education, as resulting from the Provincial Act of the Forty-first GEORGE THE THIRD, chapter seventeenth, which provides for the establishment of Free Schools, and the advancement of Learning in this Province.
