## An Act to authorize the erection of a Marine Hospital, near the Weiland Canal, for the relief of sick and wounded Sailors navigating the Lakes.

WHEREAS it is advisable to establish at some central point in the Preamble vicinity of Lakes Eric and Ontario, an Hospital or Infirmary, for the reception of diseased and temporarily disabled mariners, actually enraged in the navigation of the said waters, and it is therefore expedient to authorise His Excellency the Governor of this Province, to appoint Commissioners for superintending the erection of a suitable building upon some point on the line of the Welland Canal; and to provide for the apcontinent of proper officers for the management, and to levy a capitation ax upon all parties employed in the merchant service on the aforesaid Lakes, of not more than two shillings and six pence per month for each individual, for the maintenance and support of the same; Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:

I. An Hospital for the relief of sailors employed as aforesaid, shall be Site of Hoserected on such plot of ground, situated as aforesaid, as shall be appro- pital. priated by the Governor, or purchased by Commissioners appointed under the authority of this Act for the purpose.

II. It shall and may be lawful for the Governor of this Province to au- £5,000 approthorize a sum, not exceeding five thousand pounds, to be paid to any printed for the Hospital, Board of Commissioners, for the purpose of purchasing a site, and erecting proper buildings for the Hospital.

III. So soon as the said building shall be reported to the Governor of Commission this Province by the said Commissioners as sufficiently completed and fur- en to be apnished for the reception of patients, it shall and may be lawful for the pointed.
