An Act to enable Charles James to practise as a Provincial Land Surveyor in Upper Canada.

WHEREAS Charles James, of the Town of Stratford, in the County Preamble. of Perth, in the Province of Canada, Civil Engineer, hath by his petition to the Legislature represented, that he served from the twelfth day of August, in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred 5 and forty-three, to the twelfth day of August in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty-seven, under articles, to John William James, of Buncraggy, in the County of Clare, in that part of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, called Ireland, Civil Engineer and Land Surveyor, for the purpose of learning and practising that profession; 10 And whereas the said Charles James hath further represented that he hath also served under indenture in Upper Canada for the space of one year, in actual field practice, with Joseph Kirk, Esquire, Land Surveyor, and hath produced evidence thereof, and is desirous to be admitted to practise as a Land Surveyor in and for that part of the Province of Canada which 15 formerly constituted the Province of Upper Canada; and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition: Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:
