pealed: 3. The nineteenth section of the said Act is hereby repealed; and, steamers except only with the express permission of the Chief Emigration bound up-Agent at Quebec, no steam vessel bound for any place beyond the limwards not to receive pasits of the harbor of Quebec upwards, shall go alongside of or receive sengers from any passenger whatever directly from any vessel arriving in the Port of 5 vessels until emigrants are Quebec and having on board emigrants or passengers to whom any such landed. proclamation as aforesaid then in force shall apply, until all such emigrants or passengers shall have been landed at the place appointed in such proclamation, under a penalty of forty dollars against the Master or person in command of such steam vessel for each passenger received 10 by such steam vessel in contravention of this section.

How this Act **4.** So much of any other part of the said Act as may be inconsistshall be construed. as one Act with the said Act, and any citation of the said Act shall be understood as meaning and intending the said Act hereby amended. If
