

An Act to confirm the original Survey of the third and fourth
Concessions of the Township of Crowland.

WHEREAS Henry Buchner and others, inhabitants of the Township of Crowland, in the County of Welland, have, by their petition, represented that a certain survey of the third and fourth Concessions of Crowland aforesaid, made in the year of Our Lord, 1854, is erroneous, and have prayed that the Original Survey thereof, as traced out and confirmed by the survey of Zenas Fell, Deputy Provincial Surveyor, in the year of Our Lord, 1855, and by Andrew Hood, Deputy Provincial Surveyor, in the year of our Lord, 1859, may be permanently established and declared to be the true survey. Preamble.

10 Therefore, Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows :

I. The Survey made by Edmond Decew, Deputy Provincial Surveyor, in the year of Our Lord 1854, with the view of establishing the division line between the third and fourth Concessions of the Township of Crowland aforesaid, shall be, and the same is hereby cancelled and set aside. Survey of Decew set aside.

15 II. The Original Survey of the third and fourth Concessions of Crowland, aforesaid, as traced out and confirmed by Zenas Fell, Deputy Provincial Surveyor, in the year of Our Lord 1855, and by Andrew Hood, Deputy Provincial Surveyor, in the year of Our Lord 1859, shall be taken to have been and the same is hereby declared to be permanently established and confirmed. Original survey to be valid.

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III. This Act shall be deemed a Public Act.
