C A P. XLV.

An Act to continue until the First Day of *September* One thousand eight hundred and forty-seven certain of the Provisions of an Act of the Fifth and Sixth Years of Her present Majesty, for amending the Constitution of the Government of *Newfoundland*. [7th *August* 1846.]

**W**HEREAS by an Act passed in the Fifth and Sixth Years of the Reign of Her Majesty, for amending the Constitution of the Government of *Newfoundland*, divers Powers and Authorities were for that Purpose vested in Her Majesty, and it was thereby provided that no Change which should be made in the Constitution of the said Island under the said Act should continue for a longer Time than the First Day of *September* One thousand eight hundred and forty-six, unless Parliament should otherwise order: And whereas by virtue of the Provision last aforesaid the Changes made in the Constitution of the said Island under the said Act will cease to be in force upon and from and after the First Day of *September* now next ensuing, unless further Provision in that Behalf be made by Parliament; and it is expedient that the Changes made
