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Supervision over the Indians, more time to look after their interests and become more thoroughly acquainted with them as to their mode of life, character etc., greater progress will be made by them in every particular and that your Indians will be the first to develop themselves in matters conducive to their advancement in life.

The education of the Indian children should receive your early attention and the matter of the erection of School Houses, should be taken up at once and pushed forward.

The Department directs, that Colonel McDonald be instructed to visit you once a quarter for a year, and report on your management. This he has been asked to do.
