he was informed he should

ment without first communicating
with and obtaining authority
from the Dept. and that
he must not do it again.
The foregoing material was supplied
by the City at the rates before
quoted up to Feb. 84. In the
Apr. for July. Mar. and April
however coal was charged at
64¢ & 4¢ a ton at 3¢ per lb. to
which exception was taken by
the Dept. and a part of a
portion of the Apr. was with-
held. The City subsequently
amended the Apr. by reducing
the price of coal to 4¢ per lb.
