



Sir,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 29th ultimo, and in reply I beg to say that the Department is pleased to accept the services of yourself and Mrs. Gentleman to take charge of the class-room and field matron work respectively in connection with the Fort a la Corne School.
