Sir:-

It is necessary to again communicate with you in connection with the overdue instalment of purchase money on the S.W.1/4, Sec. 10, Tp. 20, Rge. 23, W-4-M, which became due on the 14th June last.

As the Department very urgently requires this money to be expended for the benefit of the Indians, who are the original owners of the land, I have to say that you are expected to forward without any further delay the sum of \$402.50, composed of \$241.50 principal and \$161.00 interest, which is computed to the 14th instant.

Unless you comply with this request on receipt of letter, the Department will be forced to take up the question of cancellation of the sale, forfeiture of moneys paid and redispotion of the land.
