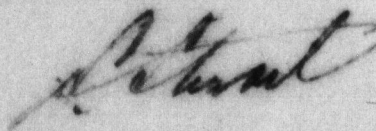
Ottawa, May 23, 1916.

The Department is not prepared to furnish such large quantities of sewing material as the teacher asks for. Some print has been sent you for the use of the destitute Indians on this reserve and the pupils might make this up.
