We require to forward this proposition to our Agent in order that he may discuss it with the Indians and possibly make some changes. It is however considered desirable that no action be taken to alienate the lands above mentioned.

Will you kindly state whether a reservation should be made in favor of the Hudson's Bay Company on account of the stage the Company has on the Northwest quarter of section 23, and if so, what should be the size of the plot to be reserved.
