
Ottawa, January 22, 1920.

Madam, -

I beg to refer to your letter of the 13th of December, last, applying for a position as teacher in one of the Indian schools upon the St. Regis Reserve and to inform you that the Department has now received the resignation of Miss Winnifred Sloane, the teacher of the Chetlain School on that reserve. Miss Sloane finds it necessary to give up her duties on account of illness and death in her family and asks to be relieved of her duties as soon as possible and, at the latest, by the end of February.

The Department will be pleased to hear from you as soon as possible whether you will be prepared to accept the position as teacher in this school at the same salary as was allowed you as assistant teacher at Wikwemikong, namely \$500.00 per annum. If you will accept this position the Department would like you to be ready to commence duties as early as possible in February. Kindly state the date on which you can take charge.
