Dear Sir:-

I am forwarding herewith application, in duplicate, legal description, in duplicate, tracing and two prints, with reference to a Provincial Government right-of-way through Boston Bar I. R. #2 (Kopchitchin) in the Lytton Agency.

The Indian Agent and the Indians of this Reserve have agreed on compensation of \$75.00 per acre for the 4.8 acres involved, and I am also enclosing Receiver-General Payment Sheet No. 5 and Cheque No. 46198 from the Provincial Government for \$360.00 in payment therefor.

I have been in communication with the Indian Agent to determine which Indians are entitled to payment for their land but, as yet no conclusions have been reached. As soon as I have definite information from the Agent, I will forward same to you.

In the meantime, I would recommend that this right-of-way be transferred to the Provincial Government.
