- 4. Measures to release increased quantities of oats and No.4 wheat for export.
- 5. Special priorities for rail transport of wheat for export.
- 6. Modificiation of regulations affecting bulk shipment of flour and feed.
- 7. A campaign to urge Canadian farmers to plan their production to obtain the maximum yield of foodstuffs over the next four years.
- 8. A campaign for the reduction of inventories of wheat and wheat products.
- 9. A campaign to encourage consumer savings, avoidance of waste and development of home gardens.

This programme has been put into effect and is already producing encouraging results. Other special action has also been taken by the government. For example, further wheat is being diverted from producers of both potable and industrial alcohol to the extent that substitutes become available; additional efforts to reduce use of wheat for animal feeds are being made.
