To encourage the Establishment of certain Societies, commonly called Building Societies, in that part of the Province of Canada, formerly constituting Upper Canada.

[18th May, 1846.]

[] HEREAS, it is desirable to afford encouragement Preamble. and protection to the establishment of certain Societies commonly called Building Societies, for the purpose of raising, by small periodical subscriptions, a fund to enable the members thereof to obtain unincumbered freehold or leasehold property: And whereas, by an Act passed in the eighth year of Her Majesty's 94, cited. reign, certain persons were incorporated as a Society for such purposes in the city of Montreal, by the name and style of The Montreal Building Society, and provisions were made for the conduct and management of that Society, and certain privileges and immunities conferred upon it: And whereas it is expedient to encourage the formation of similar Societies throughout that part of this Province heretofore constituting the Province of Upper Canada, whenever the inhabitants of any particular locality may be desirous of availing themselves of the provisions of this Act: Be it therefore enacted, by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, intituled, An Act to re-unite the Provinces of Upper and Lower Canada, and for the Government of Canada, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That when and When so soon as any twenty persons or upwards, in that part twenty persons in U.C. of this Province heretofore constituting the Province of shall agree Upper Canada, shall have agreed to constitute them- to constitute selves a Building Society, and shall have signed and Society, they
