From the various sources mentioned, it will be seen that something has been done for the support of the College. The several Committees of the four Churches of Britain have shown a sympathy for the College in the district to which so many of their people are going. Our Assembly has before declared that on account of the importance to the Church both of the Home Mission work and of work in the North-West, it is willing that the British Churches should direct its energies to the rapidly extending consideration first the claims of Manitoba College, and until a sufficient endowment has been secured, will, no doubt, be willing that this should continue. A substantial nucleus for an endowment has now been obtained, and the matter should be kept prominently before our wealthier people, especially those having interests or resident in Winnipeg and the North-West, to assist either in land or money, in order that the College may be as soon as possible free from the precarious support of annual grants and collections. The following is a statement of the various sums mentioned, including the amount of endowment already in the hands of Dr. Reid:—
