Established in 1844. Incorporated May 3rd, 1872.

The present building was erected in 1846. The Rev. Sisters arrived from Montreal in 1844 by the canoe route. Besides education, to which the Rev. Sisters devote themselves, they also attended sick persons, both in and outside.
