cified in the faid Grants, the faid perfons have taken posselfion of different Lots of ground in the faid Common, and erected Houles and other buildings thereon, and he laid before the Committee an authentic copy of one of these grants which he afterwards withdrew; the Chairman likewise informed the Committee, that fince the conquest of this Province, a majority of the Inhabitants of the faid Town of *Three Rivers*, having conjented in writing, that different perfons should take posselfion of fundry lots of ground on the faid Common, in consideration of certain yearly rents, stipulated to be by them paid, the faid perfons have taken posselfion of the faid lots and erected houses and other buildings thereon.

The Chairman likewife informed the Committee, that the Inhabitants of the faid Town of *Three Rivers*, not having the power of delegating a legal authority to any certain number of their body, for the ordering and good governing of the faid Common and collecting the rents due to them in their aggregate capacity, great inconvenience arifes to them thereirom.

REROLVED unanimoufly, that it is the opinion of this Committee, that leave be given to the Petitioners to bring in a Bill for the purpoles fet forth in their Petition.

On motion of Mr. Lees, feconded by Mr. De Bonne,

RESOLVED, that this House doth concur in the resolution reported by the Committee.

ORDERED, that Mr. Lees have leave to bring in a Bill purfuant to the foregoing refolution.

Mr. Attorney-General prefented a Petition of the Rev. Jehofaphat Mountain, and other Inhabitants of the Town of Three Rivers, whole Names are thereunto annexed, and the fame was brought up and read.

SETTING FORTH—That the Petitioners have been informed that feveral perfons refiding in the faid Town of *Three Rivers*, have lately addreffed a petition to this Houfe, for the purpofe of obtaining a Bill to authorife certain Individuals to divide and parcel the Common, belonging to the faid Town of *Three Rivers*, into fmall Town Lots, and to grant the fame to any perfons who might apply for them, by which the Inhabitants will be deprived of their Rights in the faid Common, which they have uninterruptedly
