5. The last verse is the sealing paragraph; Satan is not visible in the evil spirit. Therefore, he must have a body. And he seeks to enter into the human body. Paul saw the workings of this spirit in the man who sets himself in the seat of God. We find that Paul spoke to the Romans in Romans 1, verse 25, and this is what he said: Who changed the truth of God into a lie and worshipped and served the creature more than Creator (who is blessed for ever, amen) (Jesus, who is blessed) Psalms 72:17 His name shall endure for ever; His name shall be continued as long as the sun; and men shall be blessed in Him; All natons shall call Him Blessed; not Mary. Luke 1: 28 The Angel came in unto her and said: "Hail thou art highly favored, the Lord is with the. Isaiah 7: 15 Therefore the Lord Himself shall give you a sign; behold a virgin shall conceive and bear a son and shall call his name Emmanuel. (Note the words a virgin, a virtuous woman). 28 States as follows: Blessed art ihou among women (not above women). God tells us He is no respector of person's praise God for those words; Jesus came not to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance. Luke 1: 32 He shall be great (Jesus) and shall be called the Son of the Highest; and the Lord shall give unto Him the throne of His father David. John 17: 1 to 5 These words spake Jesus and lifted up His eyes to heaven and said: Father, the hour is come; glorify Thy Son, that Thy Son also may glorify Thee. As Thou hast given power over all flesh (not Mary) that He should give eternal life to as many as Thou has given Him. 1 Timothy 2: 5 One Mediator between God and man, Christ Jesus (not Mary). Galatians 3: 20 Now a mediator is not a mediator of one (But God is Three in One). Jesus said in John 10:30 I and My Father are One. Hebrews 9:15 And for this cause He is the Mediator of the New Testament that by means of death for the redemption of the transgressions, they that were under the first testament, might receive the promise of eternal inheritance (not Mary, she did not die for the sins of the world; the Scripture does not even record her death). Hebrews 9:24 For Christ is not entered into the holy places made with hands which are the figures of the true, but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us (not Mary). John 3:17 For God sent not His Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world, through Him, might be saved. (Not Mary). John 3:35 The Father loveth the Son, and hath given all things into His hand. Now we who know the word of God realize that the man who sets himself in the seat of God is further outlined in 2 Thessalonians 2:4 to 18. 4. Who opposeth and exalteth him-

self above all that is called God, or that is worshipped; so that he as God 🚉 sitteth in the temple of God, shewing himself that he is God.

5. Remember ye not, that when I was yet with you, I told you these things?

6. And now ye know what with-

holdeth that he might be revealed in the Children of Israel, God will help

7. For the mystery of iniquity verse 11. doth already work: only he who now letteth will let, until he be taken out

8 And then shall that wicked be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of his mouth. and shall destroy with the brightness of his coming:

9. Even him, whose coming is after the working of Satan with all power and signs and lying wonders.

10. And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved.

11. And for this cause God shall send them strong delusions, that they should believe a lie:

12. That they all might be damned who believed not the truth, but had pleasure in unrighteousness.

13. But we are bound to give thanks alway to God for you, brethren beloved of the Lord, because God hath from the beginning chosen you to salvation through sanctification of the Spirit and belief of the truth:

14. Whereunto he called you by our gospel, to the obtaining of the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ.

15. Therefore, brethren, stand fast and hold the traditions which ye have been taught, whether by word, or our epistle.

16. Now our Lord Jesus Christ himself, and God, even our Father, which hath loved us, and hath given us everlasting consolation and good hope through grace."

17. Comfort your hearts, and stablish you in every good word and work.


