

CRERAR REPLIES TO MURRAY ROSS

Denies United Grain Growers
Acted With Winnipeg
Exchange.

Hamilton, Man., Nov. 29.—Canadian Press Staff Correspondent.—Supporters of General H. M. Dyer, independent candidate in the constituency of St. George's, spoke at the meeting held here last night by Hon. T. A. Crerar, leader of the Progressive party.

"To be quite frank," said Mr. Crerar, "I don't know but they are."

Mr. Crerar suggested that they pool their interests. Mr. Stubbins, the Progressive leader, said, had stated publicly in London, "If you can't support me, vote for General Dyer. I want to get Crerar out."

Referring to the question of the inclusion against the grain inquiry commission, Mr. Crerar said that the United Grain Growers had not acted with the Winnipeg exchange, as charged by Mr. Stubbins, but quite independently in applying for the injunction. It had only taken this action after the "Port William" case, the greatest travesty of British justice, he added, that history recorded.

Twice, said the Progressive leader, the Grain Growers' Association had submitted its books to a complete public scrutiny and each time the evidence when had merely been distorted by government speakers on the public platform. The United Grain Growers had only taken action against the grain inquiry commission when it became quite certain that it was nothing more or less than a political move.
