SENTENCED TO 3 YEARS ON BLACKMAILING COUNT

Quebec Man Obtained \$109 From Doctor After Threatening Exposure.

Quebec, March 1.—(Canadian Press.)—Adelaide Denis, aged 39, was sentenced to a term of three years in penitentiary by Magistrate Choquette in the court of sessions yesterday after he had been found guilty of blackmailing Dr. L. Bernard.

Denis, it was proved, had collected the sum of \$109 from the doctor. He had gone to the doctor and had represented himself to be the husband of a woman who the doctor had treated. He said that due to neglect on the part of the doctor he had been obliged to call in other physicians, and as a result of the neglect his wife was likely to die. On that occasion the doctor had given him a check for \$9. Later Denis came and threatened the doctor with arrest and exposure, unless he paid him \$109. The doctor paid the amount, but later on making an investigation he found out that Denis was not married, and the woman he had referred to was his sister-in-law. He duly lodged a complaint against Denis, which resulted in the arrest and conviction.
