NOTE PROTECTING.

A Talk With a Lawyer—What a Frothing Clerk Had to Say—Another Letter.

A well-known lawyer met a World reporter yesterday and said that the World had been too severe on his profession generally. The press should only attack the "outliers" of the day. The World did not approve of the acts of the notaries public, it should rebuke that section of the profession only. For himself he got no notes protesting to do, and therefore was not notified as at present with them. But the law would first have to be changed. Business men were not to be old-fashioned, and it was a duty of the law to be changed to the smaller number of notaries public, and it was in the hands of the banks and holders of notes.

A PROTESTING CLERK.

In one of our law firms explained what he knew about it. He averaged eight or nine protests a day. They were issued in their treatment of delinquents, though other firms were much more insistent. The first step was to send the note to where it was issued, and ascertain if there were funds. If not, he returned and the protest was issued. Sometimes it was quite a tramp, and the branch banks in the west. On returning from such a tramp he had often secured notes to a trading-drawee without fees of any kind. But this was not the common practice. The lawyers generally got their full fees. However he said, he could not see reason for the protests, as the notes in nearly all cases were immediately returned to the holder, and he held them till paid, plus the notarial fees.
