As host of the Toronto Economic Summit, the Government of Canada has responsibility for the substantive and logistical preparations. Sylvia Ostry, the Prime Minster's Personal Representative for Economic Summits, is responsible for the substantive preparation of the Summit. The focus of her activity will be on preparing, in consultation with the Personal Representatives for the other Summit countries and the European Community, for the discussions of the leaders at Toronto. Logistical matters regarding the site, and accommodation and accreditation of officials and press delegations, are the purview of the Summits Management Office, under the direction of J.A. Doucet.
