## C. PASSPORT SERVICES

In the same year, the volume of passports issued outside Canada was 72,196, a 38 per cent increase over 1988/89. With 83 per cent of applications in Canada submitted through the 23 personal service offices, and the three-day service standard was met in 97 per cent of cases and all applications were completed within five working days. Many other documents were issued in addition, including 6,109 refugee travel documents and certificates of identity, issued to eligible residents of Canada who are not Canadian citizens.

In December 1989, the Government announced the establishment of five new Special Operating Agencies to deliver services to the public in an
