

- the corporate author (when not indicated in the subject term itself);
- the CCD/CD document number;
- the date; and
- page numbers where the reference constitutes a small part of otherwise larger document.

The absence of page numbers signifies that the document in question is devoted in its entirety to the subject matter covered under the subject term. All references to working papers are entered with the earliest document listed first.

EG. GEO-CHEMICAL SAMPLING
