60. It is noted that the French version of s.3(2) does not purport to define the word "tribunal." There does appear to be a clerical omission.

61. It is noted that no other French sections have been analyzed.

62. It is noted that the Deputy Attorney General, Del Perras Q.C. offered assistance to the Committee.

63. It is noted that due to the urgency of the matter the Attorney General's information could not be reviewed.

64. It is reported the Committee apprehends that Bill C-72 will have a serious impact on the administration of justice particularly because of the requirement that all criminal courts will be required to be functionally bilingual by 1990. I agree with Mr. Wilson.

65. It is noted that the Bill will have a profound effect on the personnel of affected courts and upon unilingual incumbents and potential appointees. I agree.

66. It is recommended that representation be made to the Federal Parliament for changes to the Bill. I agree.
