MACKENZIE KING TRUST ACCOUNT

Question No. 1,900—Mr. Stewart:

1. On what date was the Mackenzie King Trust account established and what are its aims and purposes?

2. What was the initial funding in the account and what is the present amount?

3. (a) How are funds disbursed from the account (b) to whom have funds been disbursed and for what reason?

4. Who are the trustees of the account and what remuneration, if any, is paid to each?

Mr. Peter Stollery (Parliamentary Secretary to Secretary of State and Minister of Communications): I am informed by

the Public Archives that the reply to the above question is as follows: 1. Mackenzie King Trust account was established in 1952 and the interest is used to assist in the maintenance and care of Laurier House as a place of historic interest. The property is situated at 335 Laurier Avenue East in the city of Ottawa.

2. The initial funding was \$225,000 and the present amount is \$270,274.74.
