4th. The number of men and teams employed at the present time; and when none are employed, the date at which work was suspended.

5th. The names of the Engineers, Assistants, or other persons employed in superintending the work from its commencement to the present time, with the date of appointment and rate of salary. Also, a copy of the form of contract, and the specification or document containing theinformation furnished to contractors; to enable them to estimate the extent and value of the work to be tendered for; and to guide them in performing it.

6th. Also, an account of all money expended on the line for explorations, surveys, or other purposes, from Mr. Fleming's appointment to the appointment of the Commissioners; and copies of all accounts of expenditure and liabilities furnished by the Commissioners to the Receiver General, from the date of their appointment up to the present time; as required by the 24th Section of "An Act respecting the

construction of the Intercolonial "Railway."
