

MEMBERS TO BE NOTIFIED 48. Whenever any Subordinate Lodge shall have its Charter suspended for failure to make its monthly report or to pay assessment or calls made upon it as required, it shall be the duty of the Grand Master Workman to cause each member of the Lodge to be notified of the fact by letter mailed to the last known post office address of each member.

AGENCIES OF OFFICERS 49. The officers of Subordinate Lodges shall be and are the agents of the Grand Lodge in the transaction of all the official business required of them by this General Law. The duties of the Financier or other officers of a Subordinate Lodge connected with re-instating members or the deposit or the transmission to the Lodge of the moneys required, creates no responsibility upon the Grand or Subordinate Lodge until all the laws relating to the re-instatement have been complied with.

II.

SUB-LODGES NOT TO BE INCORPORATED Subordinate Lodges in this Jurisdiction cannot be incorporated. They cannot acquire real estate without the consent of the Grand Lodge, or the Grand Master Workman.

III.

CANNOT BORROW MONEY Subordinate Lodges cannot borrow money for any purpose without the consent of the Grand Master Workman or the Grand Lodge.

IV.

MEMBERS MUST REPORT CHANGE OF ADDRESS. Members must promptly report changes in their post office address to the Financier. Any injury to their membership rights resulting from a failure to comply with this law shall be the result of the member's own negligence.

V.

NOTICES—HOW SERVED. All notices required to be served on Lodges, Officers of Lodges, or on members shall be in writing or on printed forms, the blanks to be filled in writing, or in printed circulars, and either served in person, by deputy, or mailed to the last known post office address.
