

THE SENATE OF CANADA

BILL M⁸.

An Act for the relief of
Gloria Alphonsine Timmins Ferguson.

Preamble.

WHEREAS Gloria Alphonsine Timmins Ferguson, residing
at the city of Montreal, in the province of Quebec, wife
of Ben Earl Ferguson, who is domiciled in Canada and
residing at the said city, has by her petition alleged that
they were married on the twentieth day of September, 5
A.D. 1947, at the said city, she then being Gloria
Alphonsine Timmins, a spinster; and whereas by her
petition she has prayed that, because of his adultery since
then, their marriage be dissolved; and whereas the said 10
marriage and adultery have been proved by evidence
adduced and it is expedient that the prayer of her petition
be granted: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice
and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of
Canada, enacts as follows:—

Marriage
dissolved.

1. The said marriage between Gloria Alphonsine 15
Timmins and Ben Earl Ferguson, her husband, is hereby
dissolved, and shall be henceforth null and void to all
intents and purposes whatsoever.

Right to
marry again.

2. The said Gloria Alphonsine Timmins may at any time
hereafter marry any man whom she might lawfully marry 20
if the said marriage with the said Ben Earl Ferguson had
not been solemnized.
