**MEX. SITUATION
MARKET FEATURE**

Events Near Home Kept Wall Street in Turmoil During the Day.

TIME MONEY VERY DULL

Bonds — Big Loans Are Pending.

NEW YORK, March 9.—For the first time since the outbreak of the European war, conditions on the stock market were today almost wholly untroubled by events near home. Latest developments in the Mexican situation, as well as the attitude of the Washington Government, drew renewed attention to affairs in the United States. Stocks manifested a moderate advance at the opening, but became moderately unsettled on an announcement that it had been decided to sell warships to Mexico. Prices became firmer later when it became known that Washington had not decided to sell the policy of non-intervention in that quarter. Recoveries to the early high level were recorded, but trading was increasingly dull with few material changes at the close.

Retirement of the Gould or dominant interest from the Missouri Pacific road, St. Louis and Iron Mountain roads were reflected by considerable activity at advancing prices in the securities of these properties. Later, however, profit-taking in Missouri Pacific caused some shading of quoted values.

Time Money Dull.

The feature of the foreign exchange market was the strength of remittances to Madrid, pesos advancing sharply because of an abrupt decline in sterling of the Spanish capital. Because of the large amount of available capital now held by local banks, time money was dull, six month loans being made at 3 1/4 per cent.

There was a marked decline of futures for grain and oil. Our bankers announced an impending loan of \$10,000,000 to the Government of Switzerland in the form of one to five year five per cent notes, the proceeds to be used for purchases in this country. The notes will be offered to the public at a price slightly under par, according to report. Total bond sales, \$1,417,000.

**AN ACTIVE MARKET
BUT RUN WAS LIGHT**

Very Few Good to Choice Cattle Were on Sale Yesterday.

STOCKERS AND FEEDERS

Supply Equal to Demand, Former Not Being Very Heavy.

At the Union Stock Yards on Tuesday there were 45 carloads, comprising 615 cattle, 852 hogs, 75 sheep and lambs and 45 calves.

Very few good to choice cattle were on sale, the bulk being of the common and medium grades.

There was a good, active market, and the run was light, prices were not very high on Monday.

The world heard of two loads of good to choice cattle, selling at \$7.75, which was the highest value quoted for loads.

Canners and cutters, as usual, were in demand for the better quality feeders, 700 to 800 lbs., were principally the class looked for.

Milkers and springers, with youth, on the side, as well as a number of extra good milking qualities, were the class of cows that nearly every dealer was looking for, and they were scarce at firm prices.

The bulk offered were of the common, medium, average kind, that few dealers care to handle, but they all sell at a price, and in many instances they are a source of loss to those dealing in them.

The number of calves on sale was scarcely enough to make a market, and they sold at very low values.

The betwixt-and-between season for sheep and lambs is here once more, and both are scarce and of high value. Only a limited number of hogs was on sale, and drovers were asking accordingly, which was more than the packers were prepared to pay in many instances, but as will be seen by sales quoted below, values were very firm.
