It is a work which does honour to their zeal, and is an ornament to a very pleafant country, contiguous to fertile islands, and the waters of the river St. Laurence. Mountains towards the southwest are seen, which are in the State of New-York, and neighborhood of Lake Champlain—Roads from hence, and from an American plantation, making on the side of the States opposite Johnstown, or Oswegatche, will expedite the communication with Albany and New-York, and shortens the present route more than one hundred miles. The country is well calculated for this purpose.

The British nation pay a salary to the Catholic minister of St. Regis, and a presbyterian minister on the opposite shore. At Cornwall and Johnstown, they are about to erect and maintain churches and academies, and a sum is assigned for the purpose.

Kingston is a considerable town in the Up-
