THE KLONDIKE DEAL

The universal disapproval with which the Klondike Railway policy of the Government is viewed by the independent press and the half-hearted support accorded it, even by the thorough partisans of the Administration afford sufficient evidence as to the ill-considered and injurious character of its provisions, under the amendments to which Government has consented. The only plea advanced in its favor is that of urgency, and this plea is a condemnation of the remissness exhibited in delaying action for so many months after the necessity for prompt action became evident.

The extensive discussion which has taken place in Parliament and out of it shows that the proposed scheme and agreement are condemned for many reasons, among others: That such an important enterprise should not have been undertaken until Parliament had authorized it, and had consented to the conditions proposed; That no contract of this magnitude should be let until tenders had been publicly invited and sufficient time given for preparing and submitting such tenders;

That every such contract should contain full specifications as to gauge of railway, weight and description of rails, restrictions as to steepness of grades and sharpness of curves, quantity and value of rolling stock to be supplied, and all other stipulations necessary to ensure an efficient railway. The adoption of a narrow gauge is a great mistake, as was fully demonstrated by the expensive experience of the inefficiency of such railways and their inadequacy to cheap transportation, on the several roads which were built on the narrow gauge system, thirty years ago, in all directions from Toronto;

That maximum rates for carriage of passengers and freight should have been established under the contract, with power reserved to Government to modify the same as future development might show to be advisable;

That no monopoly of railway construction or operation should be granted to any railway company over any portion of the Dominion;

That no preference in the shape of lower royalties on the lands of the company should have been granted, but all prospectors and miners should be treated alike;

That it would have been infinitely better to pay in cash for the construction of proposed railway. While it might not be advisable for Government to build the railway, it would have been better that it should have located its land, adopted specifications of the character of the work, invited tenders for its construction in accordance therewith, accepted the most favorable offer, and on its completion owned and operated the line.

During the construction of the railway, surveys would be employed in surveying the mining lands, and staking them off in such subdivisions as might be thought advisable, and making reliable reports as to the character of such lands, and the extent of the territory should be surveyed and reported upon, these reports should be published, and tenders for different parcels should be invited or an auction sale held, by which they would be sold to the highest bidder. There is little reason to doubt that the lands would be sold at a price realized to cover the whole cost of the construction of the railway from probably less than one-tenth of the extent of lands proposed to be granted under the present scheme. The three last quarters millions of acres of mining lands, with a probability that this may extend to five million acres, is an outrageous value to pay for the construction of this road, which has been so aptly named "a toy railway," and which, when completed, will not be the property of the people.

A few facts gathered from the conclusion of the mining industry in South Africa and West Australia illustrate the recklessness and folly of a policy which would alienate the vast extent of mining property proposed.
