"If the resolutions adopted by the provincial representatives at Quebec were accepted by the federal government it would mean that the subsidy to this province would be increased by \$600,000. Last year the lederal subsidy amounted to \$1,282,042. We do not look with favor, however, upon any such increase, as we have said before. We are still strongly of opinion that so far as possible those who spend the money should have the responsibility of raising it.
