YORK COUNTY SOLDIERS.

(Fredericton Mail)

It is reported in this city today that

Col. H. P. McLeod, who recently re-
linquished a command at Shorncliffe, is on
his way home to Fredericton.Private Fred Tyler, of St. Mary's, who
was reported missing in France some
months ago, is today reported believed
killed in action June 2nd, 1916. He is a
son of Mr. and Mrs. Jas. Tyler of St.
Mary's. He belonged to the 1st York
Regiment for many years. He enlisted
in the Composite Battalion at Halifax
shortly after the war began. When the
55th Battalion was organized early in
1915 he transferred to the 55th, with
which he went to England. From the
55th he was drafted to France.Corp. Geo. Keen, of St. Mary's, who
was reported yesterday as dangerously
wounded, is to be invalided home, ac-
cording to report received today.Lieut. Otty Croshaw, of this city,
who left with the 104th Battalion, is re-
ported in hospital in London, Eng., suf-
fering from shell shock.Word has been received that Corp.
George Keen, son of Mr. and Mrs. Al-
fred Keen, of St. Mary's, has been dan-
gerously wounded in France. He was
with a divisional signalling company.Corp. Keen enlisted shortly after the be-
ginning of the war, going to Halifax,
where he joined the Composite Bat-
talion as a signaller. Later he went to En-
gland. He has been away from home
more than two years.
